Catharina Pijls | NUTRIM Lecture

The 2009 C. Pijls / NUTRIM lecture is awarded to Dr. Pedro Teixeira, nutrition scientist at the Exercise & Health Laboratory, Faculty of Human Kinetics, Technical University of Lisbon. The 2009 NUTRIM-Lecture is also FHML's Catharina Pijls Lecture 2009. Catharina Pijls was a Dutch Pharmacologist, very engaged in society and convinced that it takes more than medicine and medical doctors to treat health problems. The Catharina Pijls Foundation was set up in 1984, and has had a close link with the former Faculty of Health Sciences from the very beginning. The Foundation's activities are partly financed by a bequest received from Mrs Catharina Pijls herself and have the objective to promote health sciences in the broadest sense. Dr. Teixeira's lecture dealing with behavioral weight management in order to prevent health problems, contributes fully to this objective.
